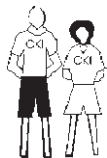


Convention Information

Attire

The following descriptions will help you determine the appropriate attire for each session.

Casual Attire



Nice shorts and shirt, district or other CKI T-shirts are considered casual. No cut-offs, holey, stained, or otherwise inappropriate clothing. If it is questionable, count it out. Casual attire is appropriate for downtime in and out of the hotel, Opening Session, and workshops that are not immediately followed by more formal sessions.

Business-Casual Attire



Any sessions that are business-casual call for nice pants, polo shirt (or the equivalent), capri pants, nice sundresses, or nice skirts. It is not appropriate to wear denim, shorts, or skirts to any such sessions.

Business Attire



At times of business, we should be dressed for business. Business attire consists of suits, jackets and ties, nice slacks, and dresses that could be worn in professional atmospheres. The House of Delegates and Caucusing Sessions are business attire. The only exemption of this is for sub-regional caucus rooms with approved themes on the second afternoon of caucusing. That afternoon you can dress in theme-wear or business attire. All attendees should be in business attire for the CKI Honors Night Session.

Semiformal/Formal Attire



Semiformal attire consists of dark suits for men and semiformal dresses for women (cocktail dress style). Formal dress consists of tuxedos for men and formal dresses for women. All attendees should be in semi-formal/formal attire for the Closing Session and Inaugural Ball and Reception.
