Have you ever not been able to find food? Have you had way too much food before? Have you always been in the middle? Do you want to see how others live? I am positive that you can answer yes to at least one of these questions. Help raise awareness and funds by sponsoring a **"Poverty Dinner."** Attendees will have the opportunity to feel what it is like to not have enough to eat, or what it is like to have all you need when others do not.

- Sell tickets for a set amount
- Assign people into different social classes:
 - **The LOWER Class**
 - **The MIDDLE Class**
 - **The UPPER Class**
- The dinner received will be relevant to the social class they are placed in (make most people lower class and have 1 to 2 dinners of the other options)
- All proceeds made would be given to a local food pantry for much needed supplies and inventory
- At the end of the evening, ask each person how they felt when they got their meal through a reflection ceremony

Examples of food prices for each class:

- \$5 and under (lower)
- \$10 - \$15 (middle)
- \$20 - \$25 (upper)
